Course Description

The world around us is changing. Today's families are overburdened, and our children are feeling stresses they have never felt before. As educators, we know that kids cannot focus and excel academically if they are preoccupied with stress or anxiety. It will offer you resources and ideas and allow you to collaborate with other elementary school professionals on best teaching practices.

Methods of Instruction

This is a self-paced online course in which participants will complete assignments independently based on provided web-materials. Interaction between participants will be encouraged through forums/online bulleting boards, but will not require live interaction. Completion of this course will provide participants with a wide variety of evaluating and teaching strategies that can be used in the K-12 classroom. Participants will focus on target competencies, identifying specific needs and finding time in each day to best suit the needs of individual students as well as the classroom community.

Students will connect with each other throughout the course within forums and various other types of onlinStudentse feedback options built into each class.

Methods of Assessment

In-service Students - Participants must complete all assignments and participate in all discussion forums throughout the course.

Professional Development Grad. Grade "B" - In addition to completing all assignments and participating in all discussion forums throughout the course, participants must submit 2 lesson plans that target at least one of the 5 competencies of SEL.

Professional Development Grad. Grade "A" - In addition to completing all assignments and participating in all discussion forums throughout the course, participants must submit 4 lesson plans that target at least one of the 5 competencies of SEL.

Instructors are online each day of the course and correspond with students through the course itself, feedback on assignments, e-mail, and by phone.
